**Location:** Red Barn Event Centre 8464 CR 27, Barrie ON

Please note day of trial entries will be accepted at this trial \$20.00 per run for fun runs only exact change only entries accepted between 9 a.m. and 9:30 a.m.

This event is a POT LUCK party! Please bring an item to share on our pot luck table.

If you have not already done so, please review your entry for classes and jump heights and notify the trial secretary at [dlmagility@gmail.com](mailto:dlmagility@gmail.com) as soon as possible of any concerns.

You will get course maps at the registration desk where you will be checking in and selecting your volunteering positions. Your entry was dependant on your volunteering for at least 2 positions during the trial, without you we would be unable to run the trial.

There cannot be food or toys within 10 ft of the agility ring during the SANCTION MATCH (this is a CKC regulation). The sanction match is run like a real trial, so there is no training in the ring.

Food & toys are allowed in the FUN RUNS but must be put directly in your furry partners mouth and not left on the floor or equipment. Please use non-crumby treats. Each team will be allowed a MAXIMUM of 2 minutes in the ring at the Fun Run. A buzzer will sound at 90 seconds as a warning and at 2 minutes we request that dogs be on leash and heading out of the ring.

**You MUST have indoor shoes when you are in the Red Barn.**

**PARKING and CRATING:** Parking is available in the main parking lot as well as on east and west side of Red Barn. You may NOT park along the laneway under the trees.

There is crating available in the Red Barn on a first come basis. The area on the SOUTH side of the ring is for **quiet dogs only**. If your dog barks or whines while you are helping in the ring, please crate in EAST crating area outside of rubber area. Competitors may crate from their car but we will not have anyone calling out for dogs in the parking lot so if you are crating there you are responsible for being at the ring on time.

Running order for the day is: Running Small to tall

You will find the results for the SANCTION MATCH posted on the table where the ribbons are located. Your ribbons are self-serve. If you do not wish to take them that is okay, we will be able to reuse them.

The CKC has also asked clubs to remind competitors of the following;

**HEALTH REMINDERS:**

No dog may be brought onto the grounds or premises of an event if it:

1. Is known to have distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease;
2. Has recovered from distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease within the last 30 days (prior to the event);
3. Has been housed within 30 days prior to the event on premises on which there existed distemper, parvovirus, kennel cough or other communicable disease.

Clubs do have the right to remove a dog from the event premises and the exhibitor may be subject to disciplinary action if it is found that CKC rules have been contravened.

**In order to make everyone's visit a safe and enjoyable one, we have just a few rules:**

- PLEASE drive slowly down the long driveway. 10 km limit!
- There is a private residence at the front of the property. Do not walk your dogs down the driveway towards the residence as it upsets the dogs who live there.
- Only park in the designated parking area.
- Dogs must be on leash at all times, except when competing in the ring. No exceptions.
- Not all dogs love other dogs. Please keep your dog under control and out of other dogs' faces, even if your dog is friendly.
- Garbage policy at the Red Barn "IF YOU BRING IT PLEASE TAKE IT HOME WITH YOU" There will be a garbage can for the dog poop outside the door but that is all that can be put into it.
- No smoking anywhere on the trial site.
- Please do your best to keep barking to a minimum
- Be nice to our judges and volunteers. Remember if you want to be treated with respect – give others the same respect. We have a zero tolerance for any abuse of dogs or humans.
- Agility is a team sport, so please leave prong collars and other correction gear at home. Remember we enter the ring as friends and leave the ring as friends.
